Great ways to raise money towards your shave:



1. Set up Swear Jars in the canteen and wet mess – fine your workmates \$10 every time they swear. We can send you tins or boxes for this.

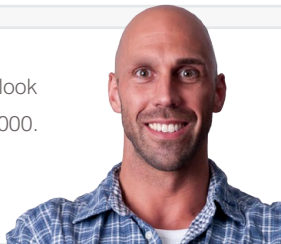


6. Hold an Original Mine Outfit contest. Charge an entry fee to all competitors to find out who can come up with the most original or outlandish mine outfit.

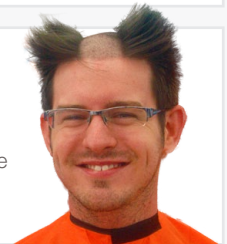

10. Ask one of the bosses if they will shave their head, or colour their hair for a day. Set a high target and if everyone on site pitches in, the boss will go through with the challenge. You can raise extra money by auctioning the privilege of shaving the boss in front of a crowd.
